



HARPENDEN HALL, HERTS.

(Formerly Senior Mistress of Prior's Field, Godalming).

HARPENDEN HALL stands on high ground, facing the Common, and has a south-west aspect. It contains accommodation for 24 girls. The soil is gravel. There is a large, old fashioned garden with tennis and croquet lawns, and also a field for games.

Miss English has studied the modern methods of teaching in England and on the Continent, especially in Germany, visiting the public schools for that purpose. She has specialised in History and Modern Languages. Her object is to receive a limited number of girls, and to give them the care and individual attention which it is impossible for larger schools to provide, combining the freedom and happiness of home life with the discipline essential in a school.

Health is the first consideration. There is a fitted gymnasium, and great attention is paid to physical exercises. Half an hour every day is set apart for Swedish drill, and as much time as possible spent out of doors. Each girl has her own garden, and gardening is taught by a lady gardener.

During the term occasional visits are made to museums, art galleries, and other places of interest in London.
